# Food Services Internship



The **St. Jude Food Services High School Internship** offers a unique opportunity for East High School seniors to participate in a work-based learning experiences in the St. Jude Food Services Department. The purpose of the program is to prepare students for careers in the culinary and hospitality industries by providing hands-on experience in a professional food services environment. Interns will gain valuable skills in food preparation, customer service, and kitchen operations while working alongside industry professionals at St. Jude.

## Duration of the Program

The St. Jude Food Services High School Internship is a year-long program that consists of a full time (40 hours per week) 2-week summer orientation and a part-time (~20 hours per week) experience during the academic year (September - May).

**2-Week Summer Orientation Schedules:** Daily schedules during the summer orientation are restricted to a typical 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day. Students are expected to attend all 2-weeks of the program. The 2025 summer orientation will begin on June 2, 2025 and end June 13, 2025.

**Academic Year Schedules:** Weekly schedules during the academic year will include 10 hours during the weekday (Monday-Friday) and 8 hours each Saturday. Exact weekdays and hours will be determined in collaboration with the student and their school administration.

## Student Eligibility

Eligible high school students must:

- Be a current junior at East High School
- Be 16 years old or older
- Be eligible for the work-study program offered through MSCS CTE
- Have an attendance record with no more than 4 absences and fewer than 10 tardies
- Complete the online application
- Provide written permission from a legal guardian if selected
- Submit an official transcript if selected

## Student Compensation

All students will receive a summer stipend for participation in the 2-week orientation and are expected to work 40 hours per week. Students will receive an additional monthly stipend during the academic year and are expected to work ~20 hours per week.
